KPI Series: KPI 5 –
Productivity, Part 1.

Productivity and efficiency go hand in hand. If your people are productive, but there are holes in your systems and procedures, both your team and you are losing valuable opportunities to make more money and complete more work. Productivity has to be reviewed both individually and team-wide – each skilled employee is at a different skill and experience level and must be evaluated at the level they are at. For example, in the automotive repair industry, a tire and lube tech is not expected to perform the same work as a Master Certified Technician who has both extensive training and years of experience. When I look at productivity, I ask the owner/manager to evaluate the skill level of each skilled employee based on training and experience. This gives us an idea of how many hours of work can be sold for that employee. After the number of producible hours is determined, we start looking at the past 8-12 weeks and see how the production employees stack up against this measure individually and as a team. If they are on target, we move forward. If they are missing the mark, the questions begin

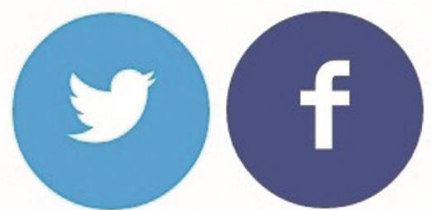

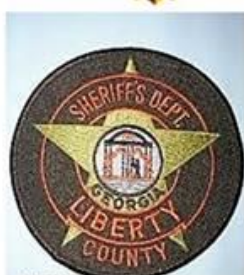

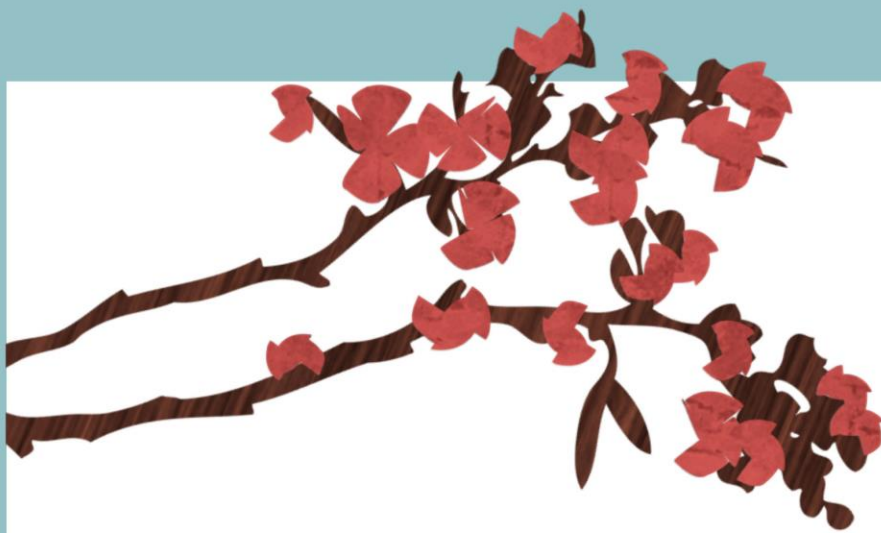

In February 2012, Governor Deal launched REACH (Realizing Educational Achievement Can Happen) Georgia, a needs-based scholarship program that seeks to increase the high school graduation rate and better prepare students for college and careers. REACH is different than most scholarship programs in that it identifies low-income students with academic promise while they are still in their critical middle school years, giving them hope that a post-secondary degree is in fact within their reach. Students sign a contract to maintain a 2.5 grade point average, remain crime and drug free, and commit to meet with a mentor and academic coach until they graduate from high school. Students who complete these program requirements receive a \$10,000 scholarship (\$2,500/year) towards the educational costs at a two-year or four-year University System of Georgia, Technical College System of Georgia, or eligible private postsecondary institution.

We believe that the priorities of REACH Georgia, supporting low-income, at-risk students, beginning in the 8th grade, in their efforts to attain post-secondary education, align well with the existing initiatives and programs that have earned corporate and philanthropic support. Currently, Liberty County Schools has five REACH Scholars. They are in the process of selecting five new 8th graders to become this year's cohort of REACH Scholar with the community's support. Liberty County School System needs your help to raise a small part of their local investment for their next cohort of students. For each \$2,500 they raise, the state will match at \$7500 allowing an additional 8th grader to get on the path to graduating from high school and accessing and completing college. Additionally, 100% of your tax-deductible donation goes directly to student scholarships in Liberty County. Our public and private institution partners are matching and in some cases double matching the scholarship, allowing our Scholars to have access to \$20,000 or \$30,000 to pursue their postsecondary degrees.

Please consider helping Liberty County Schools maximize the number of scholars they can add to this school year's cohort. Any amount is appreciated and will help us change the life of a deserving student.

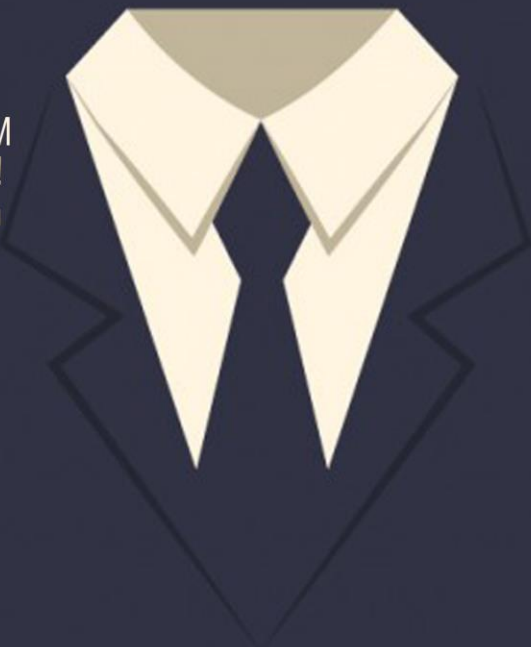
