

On Monday, March 9<sup>th</sup> 2015 the Georgia House of Representative passed a resolution to proclaim the day 3<sup>rd</sup> Infantry Division Day. The event was organized by the Liberty County Chamber of Commerce and Convention and Visitors Bureau with much help from Rep. Al Williams of Midway.

Many leaders of the community along with Gen. Blackburn and Col. Gregory from Ft. Stewart were present for the occasion. MG Murray joined us for the event via Skype from Afghanistan.

"As the President of the Eleven Black Men of Liberty County, Inc. I am humbled and at the same time grateful for the support that our organization continues to receive from not only the community at large but world renowned individuals and community leaders such as our guest speaker DeLisha Milton-Jones," said Barry Chapman, organization President. He further stated that he feels that the organization itself is "rich" because of a quote he once heard that says, "It is not what you have that makes you rich it's how much you give."

The keynote speaker is DeLisha Milton-Jones, a WNBA Champion and Olympic Gold Medalist originally from Liberty County.

"It's indeed a privilege and an honor to be the keynote speaker for the Eleven Black Men. I take a lot of pride in being socially responsible," said Milton-Jones. "Being a mentor is my way of paying it forward. Someone mentored me at different levels of my growth, so it's only right that I give back what's been given to me. Giving back to MY community is a very powerful thing to do because I'm affecting the very byproducts of it. Kids from small towns like ours need visible examples of success so that they can see how real dreams can become."

The Eleven Black Men of Liberty County is a non-profit organization whose vision statement is "To become the county's strongest, most self-reliant volunteer organization focused on education, enrichment and empowerment for our young men."

"Everyone at some point in time has experienced setbacks in some type of way or form. The first instinct for some people is to stop and reflect on those setbacks. Instead of doing that, you must keep moving forward and keep focusing on the future," said Philip Williams, a former Transcender (a mentee) of the Eleven Black Men.

"On behalf of our organization we are proud to have the support of the community and Champions like DeLisha whose presences and contributions help us to give and continue to give to assist those in need throughout our community and beyond," said Chapman, organization President.





