

The following rules/guidelines will be adhered to in the interest of having a safe 2020 Christmas Parade.

### **Signage**

- Place signage at the entrance to the parade staging area to instruct that people cannot enter if they have been diagnosed with COVID-19, have exhibited symptoms or have had contact with a person that has or is suspected to have COVID-19 within the last 14 days.
- Place signage at the information tent inside the parade staging area to instruct that people that they must leave if they have been diagnosed with COVID-19, have exhibited symptoms or has had contact with a person that has or is suspected to have COVID-19 within the last 14 days.
- Placing signage at the information table regarding enhanced sanitation procedures, social distancing and other instructions & limitations.
- Placing signage throughout the staging area regarding enhanced sanitation procedures, social distancing and other instructions & limitations.
- Placing signage throughout the parade route regarding enhanced sanitation procedures, social distancing and other instructions & limitations.

### **Education**

- An active social media campaign the month prior to the parade educating both those who will attend and those who will participate regarding enhanced sanitation procedures, social distancing and other instructions & limitations.
- Publishing article/letters to the editor with the local newspaper regarding enhanced sanitation procedures, social distancing and other instructions & limitations.
- Requesting City of Hinesville support with the education of citizens regarding enhanced sanitation procedures, social distancing and other instructions & limitations.

### **Precautions**

- Require the organizing participant for each entry to certify in writing that he/she has not been diagnosed with COVID-19, have exhibited symptoms or has had contact with a person that has or is suspected to have COVID-19 within the last 14 days.
- Providing PPE to workers, volunteers & participants as available and appropriate.
- To the extent practicable, eliminating the need for patrons to touch surfaces in public places.
- Implementing assigned entrance and exits.
- Requiring adequate physical space between parties of entries to enforce proper social distancing protocol.
- Providing more space between entries to ensure the utilization of social distancing.
- Providing staff to enforce social distancing protocol at the site of the television cameras, no viewing stand allowed.
- Providing hand sanitizer for use by all individuals present at the staging area. Using contactless stations where possible.
- Per City policy will require those at the staging area to wear masks.
- Staging area will be restricted to participants of the parade and staff only.
- Once checked in entries will be required to stay in the staging area.
- We will have additional bathrooms and hand washing stations, which will be cleaned every hour. The stations, along with water and soap will also have hand sanitizer available.
